(Psalm 33:1) ⇒ Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. (Psalm 150:2) ⇒ Let all the earth fear the Lord: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. (Psalm 33:8) 	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14) ⇒ Come, and let us return unto the Lord: for he hath torn, and he will heal us. (Hosea 6:1a) ⇒ Men ought always to pray, and not to faint. (St. Luke 18:1b) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Lord, help us to be patient; stablish our hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. (James 5:8) ⇒ As alarms about the new Omicron variant of COVID-19 soar, we shall not be afraid of the pestilence that walketh in darkness! (Psalm 91:6) ⇒ We apply the blood of Jesus over our By Faith Medical Teams and our church family that the plague shall not destroy us. (Romans 8:26) ⇒ The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. (James 5:16b) 	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Father, we thank thee that thou hast heard us. And we know that thou hearest us always. (St. John 11:41b, 42a) ⇒ We thank You Lord that whatsoever we ask in prayer, believing, we shall receive. (St. Matthew 21:22) ⇒ Thank You God for the help of the Holy Spirit in prayer.

(Psalm 117:1-2)</p> <p>⇒ Let every thing that hath breath praise the Lord. Praise ye the Lord. (Psalm 150:6)</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. (St. Matthew 24:14) God, help us to do our part.</p> <p>⇒ Ignite us, Father, that we go forth and preach everywhere, the Lord working with us, and confirming the Word with signs following. (St. Mark 16:20)</p> <p>⇒ May we like Jesus declare, “The Spirit of the Lord God is upon us; because the Lord hath anointed us to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent us to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God.” (Isaiah 61:1-2a)</p>	<p>⇒ We pray for those in authority including our U.S. President and his cabinet that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. (1 Timothy 2:2)</p> <p>⇒ Jeremiah 31:3 declares “I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee.” Father, strengthen us to demonstrate the love of God to reach the lost.</p> <p>⇒ We pray earnestly for our Global Missions Department for the wisdom and resources to further expand the reach of our By Faith footprint both domestically and abroad. We are thankful for our current growth but seek God to add to the church such as should be saved and willing workers that will diligently help to propel the work forward.</p> <p>⇒ We cover our COGBF International Affiliates that they will aggressively pursue the work of the ministry in the face of challenges and persecution.</p>

(St. Matthew 28:19)</p> <p>⇒ Father, the night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. (Romans 13:12)</p>	<p>⇒ We pray for the seven (or more) people on our individual prayer lists that they will answer the call to become a believer and receive God’s gift of eternal life.</p> <p>⇒ We also pray for the personal needs of those gathered here.</p>
<p>Quiet Confession <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Lord, forgive us for our negligence in sharing the Gospel of Christ with others.</p> <p>⇒ We confront and forsake our prejudices in reaching other ethnic groups with the good news.</p> <p>⇒ Father, please deliver us from fear.</p>	<p>⇒ Lord, help us to warn the people that the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. (2 Peter 3:8:10)</p> <p>⇒ We pray that we be ready to meet the Lord in the air when He returns.</p>	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Thank God we are accepted in the beloved. (Ephesians 1:6b)</p> <p>⇒ Thank You Lord that You have lost none of Your sheep. (St. John 18:9)</p> <p>⇒ Through Jesus, we live forevermore.</p>

DAY # 3 – GOD’S MISSION AND PRAYER, PART 1

(Ephesians 2:4)</p> <p>⇒ But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8) Glory to God!</p> <p>⇒ For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. (St. John 3:17) Hallelujah to His name!</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Lord, help us to watch in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of our ministry. (2 Timothy 4:5)</p> <p>⇒ Even as we are workers together with God, let us not receive the grace of God in vain. Now is the accepted time; behold now is the day of salvation. (2 Corinthians 6:1-2)</p> <p>⇒ May we fulfill the great commission of Christ who would have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. (2 Timothy 2:4)</p>	<p>⇒ Whatsoever is not of faith is sin. We received the Spirit by the hearing of faith. Father, help us that having begun in the Spirit, we are not now made perfect by the flesh. We are the just – help us to live and walk before You in faith. (Romans 14:23, Galatians 3:2-3,11)</p> <p>⇒ We must walk worthy of the vocation wherewith we are called with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. We can’t do this without You Lord – please help us! (Ephesians 4:1-3)</p> <p>⇒ Father, help us to let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. (Philippians 2:3)</p>
<p>Scripture <i>Approximately 15 Minutes</i></p> <p><i>“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”</i> <i>Acts 1:8</i></p>	<p>⇒ Help us to be ever mindful that the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost. (St. Luke 19:10)</p> <p>⇒ The Lord is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9). Father, give us the mind of Christ.</p>	<p>⇒ Lord, remember the seven (or more) people on our individual prayer lists that they will surrender to Your call.</p> <p>⇒ We also pray for the personal needs of those gathered here.</p>
<p>Quiet Confession <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ We confess that kingdom work is not by might, nor by power, but by God’s Spirit. (Zechariah 4:6)</p> <p>⇒ Father, forgive us for not being led by the Spirit of God and for allowing our flesh to get glory in Your work. (Romans 8:8-14)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we repent for choosing to offer burnt offerings and sacrifices to You rather than obeying the voice of the Lord. (1 Samuel 15:22)</p>	<p>⇒ Lord, we acknowledge that we lack wisdom for the mission but we ask You for it and know that it shall be given to us liberally. (James 1:5)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, for we see that our calling, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble are called. But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty. We pray that we crucify our flesh with its affections and lusts that it does not try to glory in Your presence. (1 Corinthians 1:26-29, Galatians 5:24)</p>	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Thank God we have been begotten through the gospel. (1 Corinthians 4:15b)</p> <p>⇒ Thank God for the gospel of our salvation by which we were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise after we believed. (Ephesians 1:13)</p> <p>⇒ Thank you Lord for using us to publish the gospel among all nations. (St. Mark 13:10)</p>

DAY # 4 – GOD’S MISSION AND PRAYER, PART 2

<p>Praise <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Praise God for His Spirit that anoints us to preach good tidings unto the meek! (Isaiah 61:1a)</p> <p>⇒ Praise God for His Spirit that anoints us to bind up the brokenhearted! (Isaiah 61:1b)</p> <p>⇒ Praise God for His Spirit that anoints us to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to them that are bound! (Isaiah 61:1c)</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Jesus came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance. Lord, help us to do the same. (St. Luke 5:32)</p> <p>⇒ God grant us a vision and hunger to know both the indwelling life of the Spirit and the outflowing power of the Spirit for the work of the ministry. (St. John 20:22, St. Luke 24:49)</p> <p>⇒ Father, unite us in praise and prayer and fill us afresh with the Holy Ghost that we may speak the Word of God with boldness. (St. Luke 24:52-53, Acts 4:24, 31)</p>	<p>⇒ The National Church is fully committed to prayer believing wholeheartedly in the power of prayer. We determine to do nothing without seeking the face of our Father as prayer is a DIVINE MANDATE!</p> <p>⇒ As the world spirals into more wickedness, we intensify our evangelistic push and show stronger support to our Bi-Monthly Prayer on the 1st and 3rd Mondays, our 24-Hour Prayer Hotline, and our 10 Days of Prayer prior to National Conventions. Father, we lift our prayers to Thee as sweet incense crying out for Your mercy and the salvation of souls in this end-time harvest! (Psalm 65:2, Psalm 141:2, Proverbs 15:29, Revelation 5:8)</p>

(St. Luke 24:49, Acts 1:8, 13-15, 2:1)</p> <p>⇒ Father, as we preach Jesus Christ and Him crucified, let our preaching be in demonstration of the Spirit and of power that our faith stands in the power of the God. (1 Corinthians 2:4-5)</p>	<p>⇒ COGBF Vision 2025 is in motion. We have vowed to move forward together in alignment with our mission and values to a better future with five wide open doors in ministry. Father, we commit our plans to Thee that they be established. (1 Corinthians 16:9, Proverbs 16:3)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, bless the seven (or more) people on our prayer lists that they recommit themselves to prayer and purpose.</p> <p>⇒ We pray for the personal needs of those gathered here.</p>

We will not fear what man shall do unto us.</p> <p>⇒ We repent for not waiting before the Lord to be endued with power from on high.</p>	<p>⇒ We unashamedly proclaim that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:10-11)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we walk in the power You gave to the church to tread on serpents and scorpions, over all the power of the enemy, knowing that nothing shall by any means hurt us. (St. Luke 10:19)</p>	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Lord, thank You for making us strong and courageous by your Holy Spirit.</p> <p>⇒ Thank You for making us sons of God and workers together with you in this mission.</p> <p>⇒ Thank You for empowering us to do greater works.</p>

(St. Luke 11:28)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we praise You for prospering us because we cleave to you and have not departed from following You. (2 Kings 18:6-7)</p> <p>⇒ With great pleasure do we offer praise, Lord Jesus, that we have made haste and delayed not to keep your commandments. (Psalm 119:60)</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ We pray for the wisdom to abide by Christ’s example and follow in His steps. (1 Peter 2:21b)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, help us to develop our friendship with You by doing whatsoever You command us. (St. John 15:14)</p> <p>⇒ Father, we submit ourselves therefore to God; resist the devil and he flees from us. (James 4:7)</p>	<p>⇒ Father, teach us to let our souls be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God and the powers that be are ordained of God. (Romans 13:1)</p> <p>⇒ Continually train us to be followers of God as dear children. (Ephesians 5:1)</p> <p>⇒ We cover 2CBF and Next Gen that they yield themselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and their members as instruments of righteousness unto God. (Psalm 128:1)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, teach us to do Your will for thou art our God. (Psalm 143:10a)</p> <p>⇒ We are your sons and daughters; we receive your sayings and the years of our lives shall be many. (Proverbs 4:10)</p> <p>⇒ And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever. (1 John 2:17)</p>	<p>⇒ Let our COGBF Deacons / Deaconesses manage our church business well by holding the mystery of faith in a pure conscience. (1 Timothy 3:9)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we pray for the seven (or more) people on our prayer lists that they will experience blessing from their obedience.</p> <p>⇒ We pray for the personal needs of those gathered here.</p>
<p>Quiet Confession <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Father, we repent for calling You, Lord, Lord, and not do the things which you say. (St. Luke 6:46)</p> <p>⇒ We confess we have erred in our love for You by not keeping your commandments. (St. John 14:15)</p> <p>⇒ We have been disobedient by fashioning ourselves to our former lusts in our ignorance. (1 Peter 1:14)</p>	<p>⇒ We declare by faith that we are doers of the Word and not hearers only, deceiving our own selves. (James 1:22)</p> <p>⇒ We resolve to keep the charge of the Lord, walk in His ways, keep His statutes and commandments, judgments, and His testimonies that we may prosper in all that we do. (1 Kings 2:3)</p> <p>⇒ Because we obey Your voice and keep Your covenant, we are a peculiar treasure unto You above all people.</p>	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Thank You Lord that because we are willing and obedient, we eat the good of the land. (Isaiah 1:19)</p> <p>⇒ We are thankful that our house stands firm upon a rock because we hear and do the sayings of Jesus. (St. Matthew 7:24)</p> <p>⇒ Thank You Father that You become an enemy to our enemies and an adversary to our adversaries when we obey Your voice. (Exodus 23:22)</p>

<p>Praise <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for Thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. (Psalm 67:4)</p> <p>⇒ Praise God that He cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall He judge the world, and the people with equity. (Psalm 98:9)</p> <p>⇒ Praise God that we have confidence that He which hath begun a good work in us will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ! (Philippians 1:6)</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. Help us all to stand in a holy place. (St. Matthew 24:15)</p> <p>⇒ Father, prepare us as one day the saints shall judge the world. Help us not to be unworthy to judge even in the smallest matters. (1 Corinthians 6:2)</p> <p>⇒ Under no circumstance will we cast away our confidence in God. It has great recompense of reward. (Hebrews 10:35)</p>	<p>⇒ There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it. We can trust His word. (1 Corinthians 10:13)</p> <p>⇒ We serve an all-wise God! The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations; and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished. (2 Peter 2:9)</p> <p>⇒ Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall. (1 Corinthians 10:12)</p>
<p>Scripture <i>Approximately 15 Minutes</i></p> <p><i>“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will.” Ephesians 1:3-5</i></p>	<p>⇒ But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul. (Hebrews 10:39)</p> <p>⇒ Let us not straddle the fence. Help us to choose this day whom we will serve and come to the conclusion that as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. (Joshua 24:15)</p> <p>⇒ But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Lord, stir our faith. (Hebrews 11:6)</p>	<p>⇒ Father, gird up the Body of Christ that we put on the whole armour of God, that we may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand, Stand therefore, having our loins girt about with truth. (Ephesians 6:13-14)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we pray for seven (or more) people on our individual prayer lists that they find their safety and hiding place in God that their lives be hid with Christ in God.</p> <p>⇒ We pray for the personal needs of those gathered here.</p>
<p>Quiet Confession <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Father, examine me, O Lord, and prove me; try my reins and my heart. (Psalm 26:2)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, cleanse me from secret faults. (Psalm 19:12)</p> <p>⇒ I want to be a follower of Christ. Help me to be one of His disciples even through times of adversity and chastisement.</p>	<p>⇒ Elijah came unto all the people and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? If the Lord be God, follow Him: but if Baal, then follow him. In this hour, let there be no doubt in our hearts about our decision to follow Christ. (1 Kings 18:21)</p> <p>⇒ Lord, we are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people, that we should shew forth the praises of Him who called us out of darkness into His marvellous light. (1 Peter 2:9)</p>	<p>Thanksgiving <i>Approximately 5 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ Thank God that His grace is sufficient for us. (2 Corinthians 12:9)</p> <p>⇒ Thank God that we are not without chastisement – we are God’s sons. (Hebrews 12:8)</p> <p>⇒ Thank God that we can cast our cares on the Lord for He careth for us. (1 Peter 5:7)</p>

(Psalm 99:5)</p> <p>⇒ Let my mouth be filled with Thy praise and with Thy honour all the day. (Psalm 71:8)</p> <p>⇒ But the Lord is in His holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before Him. (Habakkuk 2:20)</p>	<p>Supplication and Intercession <i>Approximately 30 Minutes</i></p> <p>⇒ A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas. Father, help us get our houses in order. (St. Matthew 16:4)</p> <p>⇒ We must work the works of Him that sent us, while it is day; the night cometh and no man can work. Let us not put off today for tomorrow. (St. John 9:4)</p>	<p>⇒ COGBF Vision 2025 outlines that we must be the called-out church “Ekklesia” in this post-pandemic culture.
