**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: ISAIAH 43:2 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through fire, thou shall not be burned.; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*{Privately go before God and confess our sins, faults, and mistakes.}*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father God, we pray for those who have abandoned your precepts and examples.
- ⇒ Forgive us of our slothfulness in serving you with all our heart, mind, body, and soul.
- ⇒ Lord God, bless our spiritual leaders as they continue to seek your face in leading your flock.
- ⇒ Lord, open the eyes of every believer so we will see the urgency to draw closer to you as the evil days are intensifying.
- ⇒ Father God, help us to keep in remembrance of all your benefits toward us.
- ⇒ Lord, may we continue to acknowledge you as the only sovereign God.

## Day #2: God's Eagle Wings of Protection

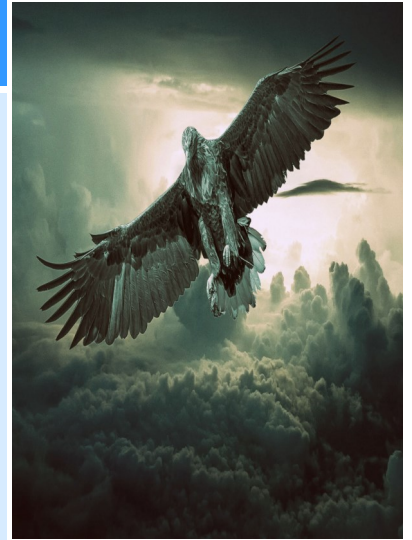
**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-minutes (Sing a song or Hymn)*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: ISAIAH 46:3-4 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, which are borne by me from the belly, which are carried in the womb. And even to your old age I am he; and even to hoar hairs will I carry you: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and I will deliver you.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately go before God and confess our sins, faults, and mistakes.)*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Lord, we pray and ask you for wisdom on every decision regarding our lives. Help us to discern the righteous path in which God desires us to take.
- ⇒ We pray for those who are facing hardship due to climate changes, destructive weather conditions, drought conditions, and famine.
- ⇒ Let us not forget who rules the heaven and earth.
- ⇒ Father God, increase our humility for humankind. Forgive us for getting caught up in self pride and materialistic worship.
- ⇒ Help us to reference your authority over our lives.
- ⇒ Father God, may we give you the glory for all the benefits that you have bestowed upon us.
- ⇒ Father, we stand in the need of compassion for humanity. Help us to reach out with hearts and hands of compassion to provide for the physical and spiritual needs of others.

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: PSALM 54:1-4 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength. Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth. For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah. Behold, God is mine helper: the Lord is with them that uphold my soul.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately go before God and confess our sins, faults, ad mistakes.)*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father, we pray that you will protect your people from the evil workers of iniquity.
- ⇒ Lord, shield your people from the arrows of destruction that flies in darkness.
- ⇒ In times of trouble, be our strong deliverer, and uphold us with the right hand of thine righteousness.
- ⇒ For our God is a strong tower and a mighty fortress. He is a very present help in the time of war.

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

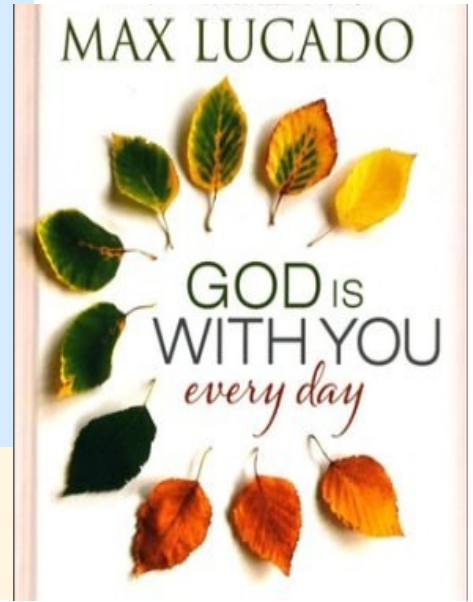
**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: ST. JOHN 15:7-8 (KJV)**

**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

## Day #5: How Do We Carry the Presence of God?

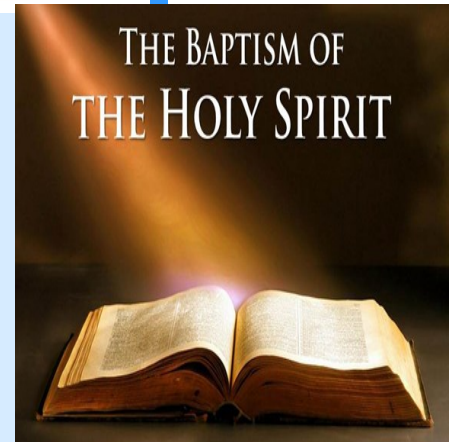
**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: MICAH 6:8 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Lord, we pray that the treasures of our heart are in heaven and not in the treasures of this world.
- ⇒ Lord, we shall keep and obey your commandments to show forth our love toward you and your Holy name.
- ⇒ Lord, may we continue to teach and learn of your goodness and your statutes.
- ⇒ Father, we will present our bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable unto you God, for you are our spiritual worship.
- ⇒ Lord, we surrender our lives to you by placing our bodies on the altar before God to say, "I am no longer my own, but yours to command and to do with what you desire."
- ⇒ Lord, help us to be that generation that hath clean hands and pure hearts; a people that will not lift up their souls unto vanity, nor live deceitfully.

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: PSALM 5:12 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.*

**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*



**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father, for 110 years, You have blessed us and been our dwelling place in every generation, and we believe You shall abide with us continually.
- ⇒ Father, Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come. (Psalm 102:13)
- ⇒ Lord, our forefathers miraculously escaped from dangers seen and unseen; we believe that no evil will befall us, neither any plague will come nigh our dwelling.
- ⇒ We know that there is no secret what God can do; He will do marvelous works and wonders among His people.
- ⇒ Lord God Almighty, as Thou prospered our leaders aforesaid, we ask that You remain with us. We receive Your amazing grace as our portion.
- ⇒ Father, we pray for You to guide us continually through every drought in the coming seasons that we shall be like a watered garden and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-minutes (Sing a song or Hymn)*

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: GALATIANS 3:29 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.*

**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*



**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father, we declare that You have remembered Your covenant for ever, the word which You commanded to a thousand generations.
- ⇒ Yes, Father, we remind You of Your Word, “My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of My lips.” (Psalm 89:34)
- ⇒ Lord, as the seed of Abraham, we believe that You have also blessed us to be a blessing.
- ⇒ Lord, we prophesy to 2nd Century and Next Gen that Your Spirit that was upon our fathers, and is upon us, will not depart out of the mouths of our seed or seed's seed. Your words will be with them forever. (Isaiah 59:21)
- ⇒ Father, we remind You of your holy promise, and Abraham Your servant, how You brought them forth with silver and gold with not one feeble person among their tribes. We acknowledge that You are the same today and we claim this promise for us. (Psalm 105:37, 42)

## Day #8: Carried by a Blessed Hope

**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-Minutes (Sing a song or Hymn)*

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: HEBREWS 6:18b-19 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*...lay hold upon the hope set before us: which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father, by Your Holy Spirit, give us a ready answer to every man that asks a reason for the hope that lives in us.
- ⇒ Lord, in times of adversity and delay, help us to hope in God and yet praise Him. Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but when the desire cometh, it is a tree of life, which brings rejoicing.
- ⇒ Abraham, against hope, believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations. We pray for renewed hope to inherit the promises of God in our lives.
- ⇒ Jesus, help us to not grow weary in well-doing so that in due season, we shall reap if we faint not.
- ⇒ God give us the spiritual fortitude (like Elder N. Scippio) to rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. For tribulations worketh patience, and patience, experience, and experience, hope, and hope maketh us not ashamed.
- ⇒ We pray that we will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Ghost. For now are we the sons of God, and when He shall appear, we shall be like Him. Every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself.
- ⇒ The pre-requisite of faith is hope. To have hope, we must see something. Father, help us to see our hope, and if we don't yet see it, give us the patience to wait for it. (Romans 8:24-25)
- ⇒ We pray that the saints of God would put their hope in God's Word through every trial, test, tribulation, or persecution. Our hope is built on nothing less than Jesus blood and righteousness. We dare not trust the sweetest frame, but wholly lean on Jesus' name.

- ⇒ Thank God that we are blessed as we trust in God and make Him our hope.
- ⇒ We rejoice that Jesus is our living hope. It's Christ in us, the hope of glory.
- ⇒ Against all odds, our hope prevails because we believe to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Thank God that behind every dark cloud, there is a silver lining.

## Day #9: Carried by an Unshakeable Faith

**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-minutes (Sing a song or Hymn)*

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: ROMANS 4:20-21 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform.*

**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*



**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ We pray that the saints will stand on the Word of God unmoved in faith. Help us to earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. For with God, nothing is impossible.
- ⇒ Lord, let the church believe, “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”
- ⇒ Our early church fathers demonstrated their persistent faith against opposition, racism, perils, and traveling long distances by foot and boat to do the work of the ministry. In this wicked and perverse hour, we pray for strong, enduring faith for our leaders and the body as we selflessly evangelize this world for Jesus in this era.
- ⇒ We declare, Father, great is Your faithfulness. We believe that You will hasten Your Word to perform it.
- ⇒ There is no errancy in God’s Word. As we ask in faith, nothing wavering, we receive, for a double minded man can’t receive anything from the Lord. Father, strengthen our faith.
- ⇒ The Bible declares that faith without works is dead being alone. Father, teach us to walk in the faith that pleases You, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Without You Lord, we can do nothing!
- ⇒ We know that the trying of our faith worketh patience, but Father help us to let patience have her perfect work, that we may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
- ⇒ We pull down the stronghold of unbelief in the church and we invoke a spirit of prayer and fasting among the saints, that we will see Your Mighty Hand again—the former and latter rain together.
- ⇒ Father, let our speech and preaching not be enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power that our faith doesn’t stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

## Day #10: Carried by God's Unfailing Love

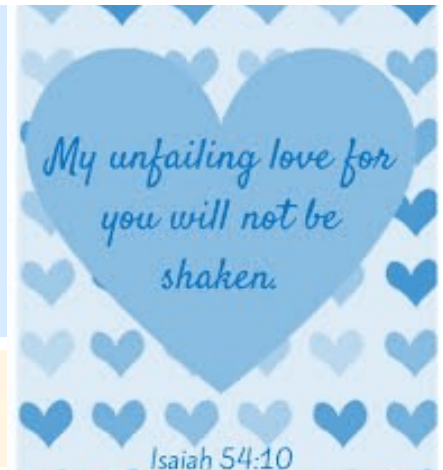
**PRAISE AND WORSHIP** - *Approximately 10-minutes (Sing a song or Hymn)*

**OPENING PRAYER** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

**SCRIPTURE READING AND EXHORTATION: PSALM 36:7 (KJV)**

*Approximately 10-minutes*

*How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.*



**QUIET CONFESSION** - *Approximately 5-minutes*

*(Privately confess our sins, faults, and mistakes before God.)*

**PRAYER AND INTERCESSION** - *Approximately 25-minutes*

- ⇒ Father, may Your everlasting love cover us continually and Your lovingkindness in us draw men to Christ.
- ⇒ Lord, You will command Your lovingkindness in the day time, and in the night Your song shall be with us, and our prayers shall be unto the God of our lives for there is no other God beside You.
- ⇒ Lord, we know that You are God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love You and keep Your commandments to a thousand generations.
- ⇒ Master, You wrought special miracles, not only by the hands of Paul, but also by our By Faith founding fathers, who were used mightily in healings and deliverance. Your unfailing love carried our fathers, so we cry today, "Visit us again Lord!"
- ⇒ Father, help us to stand in our ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, wherein is the good way, and walk therein, and we shall find rest for our souls. We need You to empower us to walk therein. Have mercy on us!
- ⇒ We ask Oh God, "Who is left among us that saw this house in her first glory? and how do we see it now? Shake us and fill the house again with Your glory Lord, for the glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former and in this place You will give us peace.

# Celebration Sunday – January 19, 2025

## OVERVIEW

Celebration Sunday should be a time of great rejoicing in all God has done throughout the ten days. This may be a time for testimonies of answered prayer, biblical teaching and preaching on prayer, and singing. Lead the congregation in a time of prayer so those who have not attended the daily meetings can experience the joy of praying with others. Each local church should use the basic guidelines below to celebrate all He has done over the past ten days. **Be flexible in your plans to follow the Holy Spirit's leading throughout the service.**

## PRAISE AND WORSHIP

This is a day to rejoice in all God has done, and music is a great way to celebrate. If a song has become a theme song for your group, make sure to sing that song with the whole congregation.

## SCRIPTURE

Read and explain the theme scripture: “Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations. Ask your father, and he will show you; your elders, and they will tell you. When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, when He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples according to the number of the children of Israel. For the Lord's portion is His people; Jacob is the place of His inheritance. He found him in a desert land, and in the wasteland, a howling wilderness; He encircled him; He instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye. As an eagle stirs up its nest, hovers over its young, spreading out its wings, taking them up, carrying them on its wings, so the Lord alone led him, and there was no foreign god with him.” (*Deuteronomy 32:7-12 NKJV*)

## CHILDREN/YOUTH

Consider involving children and youth in your Celebration Sunday. Also, if you have had children or youth involved with the regular prayer meetings, have them share their testimonies and/or lead in prayer time.

## TESTIMONIES

Consider including time for testimonies of answered prayers. Those who have participated in Ten Days of Prayer should have many stories they can share with the congregation, but encourage them to be brief so that everyone can participate. Others may also have stories. It might be good to have some testimonies pre-planned in addition to having an open sharing time.

## GOSPEL MESSAGE

The pastor or designee should preach a Gospel message related to the 10 Days of Prayer or, as the Lord sees fit.

## CORPORATE PRAYER

Invite the whole congregation to join in a time of united prayer. You could lead the congregation through an interactive prayer similar to what you have used throughout the week. Pray over a specific passage together. This could be done with people in small groups or with everyone praying together. Another option would be to have several different kinds of prayer throughout the service – praying the Scriptures, small group, individual, congregational, silent, and so on.

## BENEDICTION
